- (b) The program aims to support the participants through educating them on various topics including mental health and wellbeing with the support of program co-ordinators and mentors; and
- (c) The program will be run in partnership with Kingston High School, Taroona High School, Colony 47, PCYC and the Drug Education Network (DEN).

"Maria Island Zone" is defined to mean the area of State waters adjacent to the east coast of Tasmania bounded in the north by the line of latitude at 42° 10' South and bounded in the south by the line of latitude at 42° 49' South, and also including all the waters within Great Oyster Bay north of latitude at 42° 10' South:

"Lower East Zone" is defined to mean the area of State waters adjacent to the south east coast of Tasmania bounded in the north by the line of latitude running due east of Marion Bay at 42° 49' South and bounded in the south by the line of longitude running due south of Cape Pillar, at 148° East; and,

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
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
