# GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Fisheries (General and Fees) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2017

These regulations amend the Fisheries (General and Fees) Regulations 2016 by -

- (a) updating provisions consequent on the making of the Fisheries (Marine Plant) Rules 2017; and
- (b) prescribing royalties payable by the holder of a fishing licence (King Island kelp); and
- (c) reducing the fee payable for a variation of fishing licence (commercial dive); and
- (d) making other minor miscellaneous amendments.
  - (2) Fisheries (General and Fees) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2017

# These regulations -

- (a) amend the Fisheries (General and Fees) Regulations 2016 by
  - (i) updating provisions consequent on the making of the Fisheries (Marine Plant) Rules 2017; and
  - (ii) prescribing royalties payable by the holder of a fishing licence (King Island kelp); and
  - (iii) reducing the fee payable for a variation of fishing licence (commercial dive); and
  - (iv) making other minor miscellaneous amendments; and
- (b) rescind the Fisheries (General and Fees) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2017.
