GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Electricity Supply Industry Regulations 2018

These regulations -

(a) prescribe -

- (i) the circumstances in which licences authorising the generation of electricity are not required; and
- (ii) the information that holders of certain licences are required to publish and how that information is to be published; and
- (iii) certain requirements for the purposes of section 56 of the Electricity Supply Industry Act 1995; and
- (b) classify certain work as being of minor environmental impact; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Electricity Supply Industry Regulations 2008* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
- (2) Sentencing Amendment Regulations 2018

These regulations amend the Sentencing Regulations 2018 by prescribing certain persons as prescribed officers for the purposes of Part 5A of the Sentencing Act 1997.
