Anti-Discrimination

ANTI-DISCRIMINATION COMMISSIONER, TASMANIA
EXEMPTION/S GRANTED

The following application for exemption from the provisions of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* (Tas) (the Act) has been granted:

1. Relationships Australia Tasmania Incorporated trading as Relationships Australia Tasmania – 17/12/021 – Application for an exemption granted under section 57 of the Act for the period from 21 December 2017 to 7 November 2019.

This exemption has been granted to permit Relationships Australia Tasmania to recruit and employ two male practitioners to work in the Men Engaging in New Strategies ('MENS') Program. One male is to be based in the south of the State and one male in the north of the State. This is to enable the program to be facilitated by a team of one man and one woman (in both the north and south of the State) on the basis that:

- a) The aim of the MENS Program is to change the behaviours of men through providing intervention to improve the safety of family violence victims and their children.
- b) The recruitment and employment of two male practitioners will maintain the gender balance of one woman and one male practitioner involved in counselling sessions in both the north and south of the State. This is considered beneficial for men's behaviour change groups.

Granted on the 21st day of December 2017.

The exemption is for the period from 21 December 2017 to 7 November 2019. There is no requirement for Relationships Australia Tasmania to attend an education program to increase awareness of rights and obligations under the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* (Tas) as this has already been completed.

A person may apply to the Anti-Discrimination Tribunal for a review of the Commissioner's decision **within 28 days from the date of this notice being published.**
