LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995

PUBLIC NOTICE - DATES OF CLOSING OF
THE COMMERCIAL ROCK LOBSTER FISHERY –EAST COAST CATCH CAP AREA

RULE 11 OF THE *FISHERIES (ROCK LOBSTER) RULES 2011*

Pursuant to the powers under the Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2011 ("the Rules") that were delegated to me on 19 August 2015 by the Minister acting pursuant to section 20(1) of the Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995 ("the Act"), I determine that:

- 1) the part of the commercial rock lobster fishery that comprises of the activities of the taking of rock lobster for commercial purposes in "the east coast catch cap area" is closed from 00:01 29 January 2018 to midnight 28 February 2018 inclusive; and
- 2) the setting of a rock lobster pot for commercial purposes in, "the east coast catch cap area" is closed from 00:01 29 January 2018 to 13:00 28 February 2018 inclusive;

Where:

"the east coast catch cap area" is defined to mean the area of State waters adjacent to the east coast of Tasmania bounded in the north on the east coast by the line of latitude at 41° 16' 30" South running due east from St Helens Point and bounded in the south on the south east coast by the line of latitude at 43° 20' 00" South running due east of Coal Point (Adventure Bay, Bruny Island), excluding the D'Entrecasteaux Channel and the River Derwent.

Words and expressions used in this public notice have the same meaning as in the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* and the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2011*.
