## Weed Management

### WEED MANAGEMENT ACT 1999

Public Comment on draft statutory weed management plans under the *Weed Management Act 1999*

The Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment (DPIPWE) as part of declaration processes under the *Weed Management Act 1999* has developed draft statutory weed management plans for 32 new weeds declared under the *Act*. As part of the development of these draft plans, weeds of the same genera already declared, were amalgamated into the new draft plans. The new and existing declared weeds are listed in Table 1. Section 15(1) of the *Act* requires that statutory weed management plans be prepared for each declared weed species.

These draft plans contain measures designed to reduce the impact of weeds on Tasmania's environmental, economic and social values. These measures include: information on the distribution and extent of the declared weed; actions to prevent weed introduction and spread; and statutory management obligations for land owners.

Copies of the draft statutory weed management plans will be exhibited by DPIPWE for a period of 30 days from the date of this notice. They can be obtained at no cost from the DPIPWE website (<http://dPIPWE.tas.gov.au/see-also/public-comments-invited>).

Written submissions in relation to these proposed draft plans are invited and should be received by 5pm, Friday 29 June, 2018.

### RULES PUBLICATION ACT 1953

#### NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of the *Rules Publication Act 1953*, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:—

#### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Aboriginal Lands Regulations 2018*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe guidelines for section 28 of the *Aboriginal Lands Act 1995*; and
- (b) prescribe the procedure for hearing an appeal under section 29 of that Act; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Aboriginal Lands Regulations 2008* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(2) *Defamation Order 2018*

This order, for the purposes of section 35(1) of the *Defamation Act 2005*, declares \$398 500 to be the maximum amount of damages for non-economic loss that may be awarded from 1 July 2018 in defamation proceedings.

(3) *Evidence (Audio and Audio Visual Links) Regulations 2018*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe certain Tribunals as Tasmanian courts for the purposes of the *Evidence (Audio and Audio Visual Links) Act 1999*; and
- (b) rescind the *Evidence (Audio and Audio Visual Links) Regulations 2008*.

(4) *Mineral Resources Amendment Regulations 2018*

These regulations amend the *Mineral Resources Regulations 2016* to specify fees relating to the transfer of certain licences and leases.

(5) *Occupational Licensing (Electrical Work) Amendment Regulations 2018*

These regulations amend the *Occupational Licensing (Electrical Work) Regulations 2008* by –

- (a) including in the definition of *electrical work* work on batteries and other electricity storage systems that are permanent fixtures; and
- (b) further clarifying certain types of work that are not electrical work for the purposes of those regulations; and
- (c) removing references to demerit points from those regulations.
