### RULES PUBLICATION ACT 1953

#### NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of the *Rules Publication Act 1953*, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:—

#### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Poisons Amendment Act 2019*

This proclamation fixes 31 January 2020 as the day on which the *Poisons Amendment Act 2019* commences.

(2) *Poisons Amendment Regulations 2020*

These regulations amend the *Poisons Regulations 2018* by –

- (a) updating the penalty payable by a person for a certain relevant infringement offence; and
- (b) prescribing a certain new offence against a provision of the *Poisons Act 1971* to be an offence for which an infringement notice may be issued and served.

(3) *Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Underground Petroleum Storage Systems) Regulations 2020*

These regulations, for the purposes of the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control Act 1994* –

- (a) prescribe requirements relating to the installation, operation and decommissioning of underground petroleum storage systems; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Underground Petroleum Storage Systems) Regulations 2010* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
