GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Water and Sewerage Industry (General) Amendment Regulations 2020*

These regulations provide for service standards by prescribing stages of certain processes to be carried out and the time by which they are to be completed by a person holding a licence or an interim licence under this Act.

(2) *Residential Tenancy (Extension of Emergency Period) Order (No. 3) 2020*

This order, made under section 3A(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act 1997*, extends until 31 January 2021 the emergency period that was to expire on 1 December 2020.
