PUBLIC NOTICE: CHANGE TO FISHERIES COMMERCIAL DIVE MANAGEMENT PLAN

I, Ian Dutton, Director (Marine Resources), acting pursuant to a delegation from the Secretary of the Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment, dated 20 January 2016, and further acting pursuant to section 48A(2) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* ("the Act") hereby give notice that:

1. The fisheries commercial dive management plan has been changed pursuant to section 48A(1) of the Act, specifically: Rule 5 of the *Fisheries (Commercial Dive) Rules 2011* is changed by omitting "These rules continue in effect for 10 years" and substituting "These rules continue in effect for 11 years".
