Preliminary Recommendations of the Scientific Advisory Committee (Threatened Species)

IN ACCORDANCE with Section 18 of the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995* it is hereby advised that the Committee has decided to recommend listing the smooth handfish (*Sympterychthys unipennis*) on Schedule 3 Part 2 (endangered presumed extinct) and uplisting the Tasmanian live-bearing seastar (*Parvulastra vivipara*) from Schedule 4 (vulnerable) to Schedule 3 Part 1 (endangered). NOTICE OF DISPENSING OF REQUIREMENTS AND
ISSUE OF MODIFIED PLANNING DIRECTIVE

I, ROGER CHARLES JAENSCH, the Minister for Local Government and Planning –

- (a) issue *Planning Directive No. 8 – Exemptions, Application Requirements, Special Provisions and Zone Provisions* (the Planning Directive) under former section 13(1)(a) of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993* (the Act) and in accordance with Schedule 6, Clause 3(2A) of the Act;
- (b) having considered modifications to the Planning Directive and being satisfied that the modifications are for the purposes of correcting errors, removing anomalies, and clarifying the provisions, and that the public interest will not be prejudiced –
 - (i) in pursuance of former section 16(1) of the Act, give notice of dispensing with the requirements of former sections 10, 11 and 12 of the Act in relation to the modifications; and
 - (ii) in pursuance of former section 16(2) of the Act revoke the Planning Directive, and with reference to former section 13(2) of the Act, give notice of the issue of the modified *Planning Directive No. 8 – Exemptions, Application Requirements, Special Provisions and Zone Provisions* (the modified Planning Directive); and
- (c) in pursuance of former section 13(5) of the Act, specify that the modified Planning Directive take effect on 22 February 2022.

The modified Planning Directive implements parts of the State Planning Provisions in the remaining interim planning schemes and replaces *Interim Planning Directive No. 4 – Exemptions, Application Requirements, Special Provisions and Zone Provision*.

THE ROCK LOBSTER FISHERY FOR THE 2022-2023 QUOTA PERIOD

I, Guy Barnett, Minister administering the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act), pursuant to Section 94 (2)(b) and (c) of the Act, for the quota period from 1 March 2022 to 28 February 2023, hereby:

1. Determine the area of State waters adjacent to the north east coast of Tasmania bounded in the south on the north east coast by the line of latitude at 41° 16' 30" South running due east from St Helens Point and bounded in the north on the north coast by the line of longitude at 146° 32' 00" East running due north of Point Sorell (Port Sorell), to be the rock lobster **north east catch-cap area**; and,
2. Determine that the portion of the rock lobster total allowable commercial catch to be taken from the **north east catch-cap area** is 100 tonnes.



