### RULES PUBLICATION ACT 1953 NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

In accordance with the provisions of the *Rules Publication Act 1953*, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:-

### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Food Regulations 2022*

These regulations –

- (a) incorporate the Food Standards Code for the purposes of the *Food Act 2003*; and
- (b) specify the appropriate enforcement agencies for the purposes of the Food Standards Code; and
- (c) specify the requirements for a food safety program for the purposes of the *Food Act 2003*; and
- (d) provide for the food safety obligations for certain child care centres; and
- (e) prescribe the –
  - (i) offences for which an infringement notice may be served under the Act; and
  - (ii) relevant penalties for those offences; and
- (f) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Food Regulations 2012* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(2) *Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2022*

These regulations amend the *Poisons Regulations 2018* to authorise the possession and supply of certain substances consistent with the *End-of-Life Choices (Voluntary Assisted Dying) Act 2021*.

(3) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Health Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 2022*.

This proclamation fixes 24 October 2022 as the day on which the provisions of that Act commence.
