THREATENED SPECIES PROTECTION ACT 1995

I HEREBY GIVE notice in accordance with sections 13(5) and 14(2) of the Act that I propose to make an Order under Section 13(5) to add the smooth handfish (*Sympterichthys unipennis*) to Schedule 3, Part 2 (endangered — taxa presumed to be extinct), to omit the Tasmanian live-bearing seastar (*Parvulastra vivipara*) from Schedule 4, Part I (vulnerable), and add the Tasmanian live-bearing seastar (*Parvulastra vivipara*) to Schedule 3, Part I (endangered — extant taxa).

Appeals against the proposed order may be made to the Tasmanian Civil and Administrative Tribunal, Resources and Planning Stream, at resourceplanning@tascat.tas.gov.au within 30 days of this notification.



