Occupational Licensing

I, Ross Smith, in my capacity as Administrator of Occupational Licensing, and acting pursuant to section 99 of the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005*, hereby make the following Order:

Occupational Licensing (FOTON - Metro Hydrogen Bus Trial) Order 2024

This Order sets out the requirement for the exemption of FOTON approved technicians from holding a gas fitting licence to undertake gas fitting work and FOTON from holding a contractor's licence for the works involved in the gas fitting work above.

Version 1

This Order applies from the date of its notification in the Gazette until its amendment or revocation.

This Determination took effect from the date of notification in the Gazette 27 November 2024.

Department of Justice

1. Interpretation

"**Act**" means the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005*

"**Administrator**" means the person appointed as the Administrator of Occupational Licensing under section 10 of the Act.

"**Approved course of training**" means a course of training that has been approved by the Administrator.

"**Competence**" means a level of expertise that a person has acquired, through training, qualification, or experience, that enable the person to perform the prescribed work to a required standard and in a safe manner.

"**contractor**" means the holder of a contractor's licence, or a person who is the holder of a contractor's licence by virtue of holding deemed registration, who -

- (a) enters into a contract to carry out any prescribed work; or
- (b) employs another person to carry out any prescribed work; or
- (c) has the management or control of any other person carrying out any prescribed work;

"**Foton**" means Foton Mobility Distribution Pty Ltd

"**Gas-fitting work**" has the meaning prescribed by regulation 3 of the Regulations.

"**Prescribed work**" means any work that is -

- (a) described under Part 3 of Schedule 2 in the Act; and
- (b) determined by regulations made and in force under the Act to be prescribed work; and
- (c) not excluded from the application of the Act by the regulations made and in force under the Act.

2. Exemption of FOTON approved technicians.

1. In accordance with section 99(1)(a) of the Act, I exempt Foton approved technicians from requiring a gas fitting licence to undertake gas fitting work associated with repairing and maintaining the Foton (FTH 12 Hydrogen City Bus) fuel cell electric buses forming part of the Metro hydrogen bus trial.

3. Exemption of FOTON to hold contractor's licence.

1. In accordance with section 99(1)(a) of the Act, I exempt Foton from the requirement of the Act to hold a contractor's licence for the works involved in the gas fitting work exemption in Clause 2 above.

4. Conditions to perform and allow certain gas-fitting work under Clause 2 of the Order.

Foton must ensure a person performed work to which the Clause 2 exemption applies:

- a. ensure work undertaken is restricted to technicians and engineers approved by, and working for, Foton.
- b. ensure work undertaken is restricted to the 3 Foton (FTH12 Hydrogen City Bus) fuel cell electric buses forming part of the Metro hydrogen bus trial.
- c. ensure work undertaken is restricted to the duration of the Metro fuel cell electric bus trial only.
- d. has completed approved course of training acceptable to Foton
- e. have been assessed as competent to perform the activities by Foton.
- f. work is subject to and carried out under the management and control of Foton.
- g. work, as directed by Foton, must be in accordance with documented work procedures, practices and instructions including the undertaking and documented hazard and risk assessment, including the associated mitigation and control measures, for the work functions.
- h. creation and maintenance of a register which records the names of the competent person performing the work, dates the training and competence was undertaken or assessed, work function the individual is authorised to perform, name of the approved training.
- i. all records in point h above, must be made available to the Administrator if requested to ensure compliance to the exemption is being adhered to.
- j. ensure that in undertaking the work it does not place themselves in a position where a conflict of interest exists, and, if a conflict of interest does arise, it must notify the Administrator in writing immediately.

5. Training approved by the Administrator for technicians to meet the exemption requirements of Clause 2.

Foton technicians and engineers are required to have completed and passed:

- a. TAFE NSW "Introduction to fuel cell electric vehicles, systems and components" (Product ID 113080); and
- b. TAFE NSW "Get to know the Foton FTH12 Hydrogen City Bus" (Product ID 113187); and
- c. CATL (battery) Level 2; and/or
- d. Original equipment manufacturer training.

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Firearms Amendment Regulations 2024*

These regulations amend the *Firearms Regulations 2016* by –

- (a) prescribing gel blasters and modified toy firearms as firearms; and
- (b) declaring toy foam blasters not to be firearms.

(2) *Police Offences Regulations 2024*

These regulations, for the purposes of the *Police Offences Act 1935* –

- (a) prescribe public places where consumption of liquor is permanently or periodically prohibited; and
- (b) prescribe offences for which vehicles can be confiscated or clamped under the Act; and
- (c) prescribe certain miscellaneous matters including persons, fees, amounts and infringement notice offence penalties; and
- (d) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Police Offences Regulations 2014* under section 11(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(3) *Dairy Industry Regulations 2024*

These regulations, for the purposes of the *Dairy Industry Act 1994* –

- (a) prescribe the components of "flavoured milk" and "modified milk"; and
- (b) prescribe fees in respect of the licensing of dairy farmers, manufacturers, processors and vendors; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Dairy Industry Regulations 2014* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(4) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Farm Debt Mediation Act 2024*

This proclamation fixes 4 December 2024 as the day on which the provisions of that Act commence.

(5) *Racing Regulation and Integrity Regulations 2024*

These regulations prescribe various matters for the purposes of the *Racing Regulation and Integrity Act 2024* including –

- (a) matters relating to bookmakers' registration bonds; and
- (b) requirements on betting by and with bookmakers; and
- (c) conditions which may be imposed on race field information publication approvals; and
- (d) fees and deposits payable under that Act.

(6) *Child and Youth Safe Organisations Amendment Regulations 2024*

These regulations amend the *Child and Youth Safe Organisations Regulations 2023* to enable certain information to be shared to, and by, the independent review into concerns raised by the Commission of Inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's Responses to Child Sexual Abuse in Institutional Settings.

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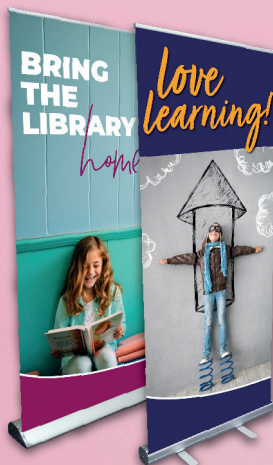
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
