Waste and Resource Recovery Act 2022

Section 6 Ministerial Order

Waste Levy Exclusion - Special Circumstances

I, Nick Duigan MLC, as the Minister for Parks and Environment and the Minister administering the *Waste and Resource Recovery Act 2022* (the Act) hereby give notice that I have made the following Order under section 6 of the Act.

The Order excludes waste materials generated by the extreme weather events from the requirements of the Tasmanian Waste Levy under Part 3 of the Act.

The Order applies to all 29 Local Government Areas (LGAs) in Tasmania declared eligible by the Premier of Tasmania on 6 September 2024, under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Eligible waste materials include those materials generated by extreme weather events between 30 August and 2 September 2024, not covered by other relief measures or opportunities for resource recovery.

This Order remains in place until 30 November 2024.

The purpose of this Order is to exempt communities and businesses who are recovering from the extreme weather events between 30 August and 2 September 2024 in the LGAs declared eligible under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements, from bearing the additional burden of landfill levy payments as part of their clean up and recovery effort.

Water Management

WATER MANAGEMENT ACT 1999

Section 11 Exemption Order

Watercourse Authorities within Specified Irrigation Districts

I, Jane Howlett MP, being and as the Minister for Primary Industries and Water and the Minister administering the *Water Management Act 1999* ("the Act"), acting pursuant to section 11 of the Act hereby exempt all persons who wish to convey water, that has been taken and stored pursuant to the Act, via any watercourse located within the Irrigation Districts listed below, from obtaining a Watercourse Authority under Part 6A of the Act, subject to them obtaining the prior approval of the relevant Responsible Water Entity to convey the water.

- (1) River Clyde Irrigation District
- (2) Cressy-Longford Irrigation Water District
- (3) Lake Leake/Elizabeth/Macquarie River Irrigation District
- (4) Tooms Lake/Macquarie River Irrigation District

Conveyance of water under this exemption is subject to the condition that a 10 per cent transmission loss factor is applied, or otherwise in accordance with a water conveyance plan approved by the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania.

Conveyance of water under this exemption is subject to the condition that the transmission of water is reported to the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania at Water.Operations@nre.tas.gov.au within one day of commencement of the transmission.

This exemption takes effect on 1 October 2024 and remains in force for a period of one year unless otherwise revoked.

Expressions used in this exemption have the same meaning as in the Act.

Information

The purpose of this Order is to exempt persons, who wish to convey stored water via a watercourse within specified irrigation districts, from having to apply to the Minister for a Watercourse Authority under Part 6A of the *Water Management Act 1999*, where the relevant responsible water entity has been approved to administer the authorisation of this activity, and subject to the dam owner obtaining the prior approval from the water entity to convey water, and on condition that the appropriate transmission loss factor is applied to the conveyance of water.
