RULES PUBLICATION ACT 1953

NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

In accordance with the provisions of the *Rules Publication Act 1953*, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:-

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Administrative Arrangements Order 2025*

This order –

- (a) assigns to Ministers of the Crown the administration of Government departments, parts of departments and State authorities and Acts, or parts of Acts or subject matter of Acts, and other instruments of a legislative character; and
- (b) specifies which Government department, part of department or State authority is responsible to a Minister in relation to the administration of those Acts, or parts of Acts or that subject matter, and other instruments; and
- (c) revokes the *Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 2) 2024* and certain spent other amendment orders.
