LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995 **NOTICE FOR THE DATES OF THE OPEN SEASON AND AREAS FOR THE TASMANIAN COMMERCIAL SCALLOP FISHERY - NORTH WEST SCALLOP AREA**

I, Dr David Midson, General Manager (Marine Resources), Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania, acting pursuant to a delegation from the Minister administering the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act), in accordance with the *Fisheries (Scallop) Rules 2020* (the Rules), hereby:

1. Determine under Rule 18(a), the dates of the open season for the commercial scallop fishery, for the area of State waters as specified in clause 3 below are from 12:01am 14 June 2025 to 11:59pm 31 December 2025 or until the amount determined in clause 4 below is caught;
2. Determine under Schedule 4 to the Rules that the minimum size limit for commercial scallops of the type *Pecten fumatus* that can be taken or possessed for commercial purposes for the area of State waters as specified in clause 3 below, is 85mm at its widest part;
3. Determine under Rules 19(1)(a) and 19(1)(b), the specified area of State waters to be open to the commercial scallop fishery for commercial scallop dredging are State waters adjacent to the north-west coast of Tasmania west of a line of longitude at 146° 31.55' East running due north from Point Sorell, and north of the line of latitude at 41° South running due west of Bluff Hill Point on the west coast, excluding State waters contained within the following boundary:
 - i. bound in the north by the line of latitude 40° 19.2' S;
 - ii. bound in the east by the line of longitude 145° 04.8'E;
 - iii. bound in the south by the line of latitude 40° 21' S; and
 - iv. bound in the west by the line of longitude 144° 54.3'E;
4. Determine under Rule 19 (1)(c) that the maximum amount of scallops that can be taken from the area described in clause 3 above is 1,000 tonnes.

Words and expressions used in this public notice have the same meaning as in the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* and the *Fisheries (Scallop) Rules 2020*.
