GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Electricity Supply Industry Concession Amendment Order 2025

This order amends the *Electricity Supply Industry Concession Order 2016* by increasing the daily discounts for the medical cooling or heating concession, the annual electricity concession and the life support concessions.

(2) Electoral Disclosure and Funding Regulations 2025

These regulations prescribe, for the purposes of the Electoral Disclosure and Funding Act 2023 –

- (a) certain records required to be kept, and provided to the Tasmanian Electoral Commission, under that Act; and
- (b) the methods of disclosing certain donations and gifts made under that Act; and
- (c) classes of persons who may be appointed as inspectors under that Act.
