#### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Threatened Species Protection Order 2025*

This order amends the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995* by –

- (a) omitting certain species from the Schedules for endangered, vulnerable and rare native flora and fauna; and
- (b) adding certain species to the Schedules for endangered, vulnerable and rare native flora and fauna; and
- (c) effecting minor statute law revision.

(2) *Threatened Species Protection Order (No. 2) 2025*

This order amends the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995* by adding certain species to, and omitting a species from, the Schedules of endangered and vulnerable native flora and fauna.
