6 Continuation of temporary exemption of *Public Health (Tobacco and Other Products) Act 2023*

For the purposes of subsection 47(3) of the Act, the *Public Health (Tobacco and Other Products) Act 2023* is declared to be exempt from the operation of the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act 1997*.

Note: This section is to revive the effect of an exemption under section 46 of the Act. For that

exemption, see section 12 of the Public Health (Tobacco and Other Products)
